**Resolution to the Rules & Regulations
Inoperable Motor Vehicles**

Approved by the Board of Directors: October 25, 2007

This Resolution to the Rules & Regulation affects all lots within The Vistas Homeowners Association, and will go into effect thirty (30) day from date of mailing.

Inoperable Motor Vehicles as it relates to Section III, J of the CC&R's:

Abandoned or inoperable vehicles that pose a health/safety risk associated with leaking fluids and chemicals. Inoperable vehicles visible on any lot or parcel are defined as those which the engine, wheels or other parts that have been removed, altered, damaged or allowed to deteriorate so that the vehicle cannot be moved, driven or licensed by the State of Nevada. This also includes but not limited to, missing tires, vehicle on blocks, front windshield missing, no engine, and steering wheel missing or disassembled in any manner.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that, by the Board of Directors that the adopted amendment to the Rules & Regulations has been approved at the October 25, 2007 quarterly meeting.
